Thank you for your request for OMS input to this year's MISO Transmission Expansion Plan, MTEP20.

The OMS does not have specific feedback on the MTEP20 scope given the unique nature of this year's economic planning process. The OMS is supportive of the direction stakeholders have given to MISO to forgo development of MTEP20 futures, focusing instead on the larger effort to modify the MTEP futures process in anticipation of more sweeping changes for MTEP21.

The OMS has recently approved a set of Long-Range Transmission Planning Principles, which will guide our efforts to shape the MTEP process going forward. The principles stress the importance of moving forward in a timely manner and the leadership role OMS plans to take in this long-range planning process. We look forward to working with MISO staff and stakeholders on this effort.
