

The OMS Resources Work Group (OMS RWG) provides feedback to MISO's Resource Adequacy Subcommittee on the OMS-MISO Survey-Potential New Resources Process Review. The OMS RWG recommends the following changes to the MISO proposal that was presented on November 8, 2017.

Our recommendations are:

1. Under the "Apply DPP Study Phase Weighting" tab, MISO should add another category to "Completed DPP Phase 3" to add more weighted for that generation that has stayed in completed DPP Phase 3. The OSM RWG proposes for generation that has completed the DPP Phase 3 but does not yet have an executed GIA, the weighting percentage should be 75% of the generation's capacity.
2. MISO should add another category for the generation that has received a Certificate of Need or a Certificate of Public Convenience and Necessity (CPCN) for their state or local regulatory body. Given that generation granted a CPCN has a relatively higher degree of certainty that it will obtain operational status, this capacity should be given a higher weighting. The OMS RWG proposes a weighting percentage of 80% of the generation's capacity.
3. MISO should track what percentage of the generation in the Queue makes it through each of the respective DPP Study phases. This information should be broken down based on resource type and by ownership type (rate-regulated owner or independent power producer). This information could be presented in the OMS-MISO survey, with a more in-depth look at the RASC, and should be provided on an annual basis.
